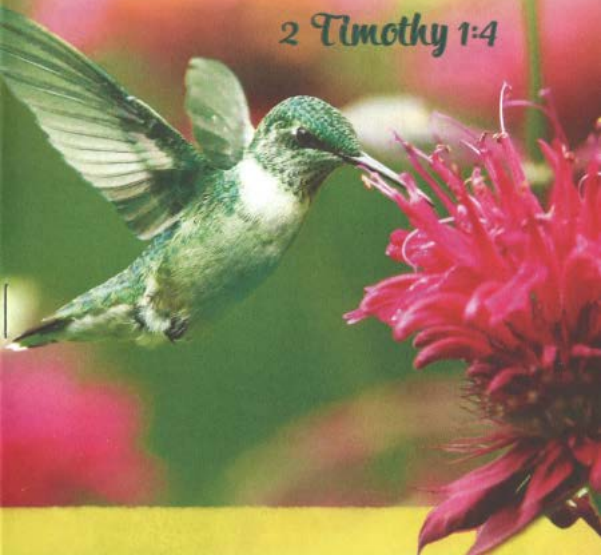

*Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord;
let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation.
Let us come before him with thanksgiving
and extol him with music and song.
For the Lord is the great God,
the great King above all gods.
In his hand are the depths of the earth,
and the mountain peaks belong to him.
The sea is his, for he made it,
and his hands formed the dry land.
Come, let us bow down in worship,
let us kneel before the Lord our Maker;
for he is our God
and we are the people of his pasture,
the flock under his care.*

HEAR THE CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth.

People: **Worship the Lord with gladness;
come before him with joyful songs.**

Leader: Know that the Lord is God.
It is he who made us, and we are his;
we are his people, the sheep of his pasture.

People: **Enter his gates with thanksgiving
and his courts with praise;
give thanks to him and praise his name.**

Leader: For the Lord is good and his love endures forever;
his faithfulness continues through all generations.

Leader: Praise the Lord.

**People: Praise God in his sanctuary;
praise him in his mighty heavens.**

praise him for his surpassing greatness.

**People: Praise him with the sounding of the trumpet,
praise him with the harp and lyre,**

Leader: Praise him with timbrel and dancing,
praise him with the strings and pipe,

**People: Praise him with the clash of cymbals,
praise him with resounding cymbals.**

Leader: Let everything that has breath praise the Lord.

All: Praise the Lord.

Leader: Let us sing a hymn of praise... You may remain seated.

SEEK ASSURANCE AND FORGIVENESS FROM GOD

Leader: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to
forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all
unrighteousness." *1 John 1:9*

*Let us pray in unison... Faithful God, who loves justice
and making broken things whole, we confess that we've
been choosing to walk in our own way. Forgive us for
the pain our choices have caused those around us and
give us wisdom as we navigate the consequences of our
decisions. Perfect Father, who is not surprised by the
extent of our own imperfection, give us a humble heart
of change. Amen.*

GOSPEL LESSON: Luke 17: 11 – 19

Jesus Heals Ten Men with Leprosy

¹¹ Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. ¹² As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance ¹³ and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!"

¹⁴ When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed.

¹⁵ One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. ¹⁶ He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.

¹⁷ Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? ¹⁸ Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?" ¹⁹ Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."

Leader: This story of Jesus illustrates praising God. It highlights that the miracle of receiving what you ask for is only the beginning while the ultimate response to receiving a blessing should be gratitude and loud praise.
